



KEY EVENTS OF SAMRUK-ENERGY JSC IN 2024

5 March	Astana Green Energy Holding Ltd is registered as a project company to implement a 1 GW wind power plant project.	24 June	The perimeter of Samruk-Energy JSC's portfolio companies includes Kokshetau TPP LLP, Semey Energy LLP and Øskemen Energy LLP.
6 March	Samruk-Energy JSC and China International Water and Power Corporation signed a Cooperation Agreement on the project of the first hydro-storage power plant in the Republic of Kazakhstan.	19 July	The Development Strategy of Samruk-Energy JSC for 2024 to 2033 was approved.
8 April	Samruk-Energy JSC allocated KZT 1.0 billion to the regions affected by floods.	26 July	A Joint Activity Agreement was signed between Qazaq Green Power PLC and Powerchina to expand the RES project to 810 MW in Almaty and Karaganda regions in the Shelek corridor.
